PRE-PROFESSIONAL GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP

Position Title:

Pre-Professional Graduate Assistant for the Alcohol and Other Drug Office.

Type of Position:

38% graduate assistantship, 9 month, beginning Fall 2009. This position is a pre-professional activity for students in Social Work, Community Health, EPS, Counseling Psychology, or Clinical Psychology.

Description:

The Alcohol and Other Drug graduate assistant (PGA) will contribute to the mission in several ways, including programming, teaching non-academic classes, and providing outreach presentations.

Duties:

- Teaching CAAP (Challenging Alcohol Attitudes Positively) – The GA will co-teach the interactive class offered for alcohol violators. A two-session class with the focus on alcohol information, a self-assessment, decision-making and values clarification.
- Teach MIC (Marijuana Information Class) – The GA will co-teach the interactive class for marijuana violators on campus. A one session, two-hour class with focus on education, decision making and values clarification.
- Work with the Alcohol and Other Drug Office, which includes conducting assessments/evaluations.
- Assist with awareness events related to alcohol and other drugs.
- Programming and outreach, throughout the campus and C-U community, with some coordinating duties related to outreaches.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Graduate student in Social Work, Community Health, EPS, Counseling Psychology, or Clinical Psychology. Preference will be given to students with prior experience working in the alcohol and other drug area. Some experience with wellness issues helpful. Awareness and willingness to work irregular hours (at times).

Compensation:

Commensurate with current UIUC policies on graduate student stipends and fee waivers. **All applicants will be required to fill out a FAFSA form to assess eligibility for Federal Work Study Assistantships.**

Application Procedure:

Review of applications will begin April 1, 2009 and will continue until the position is filled.
